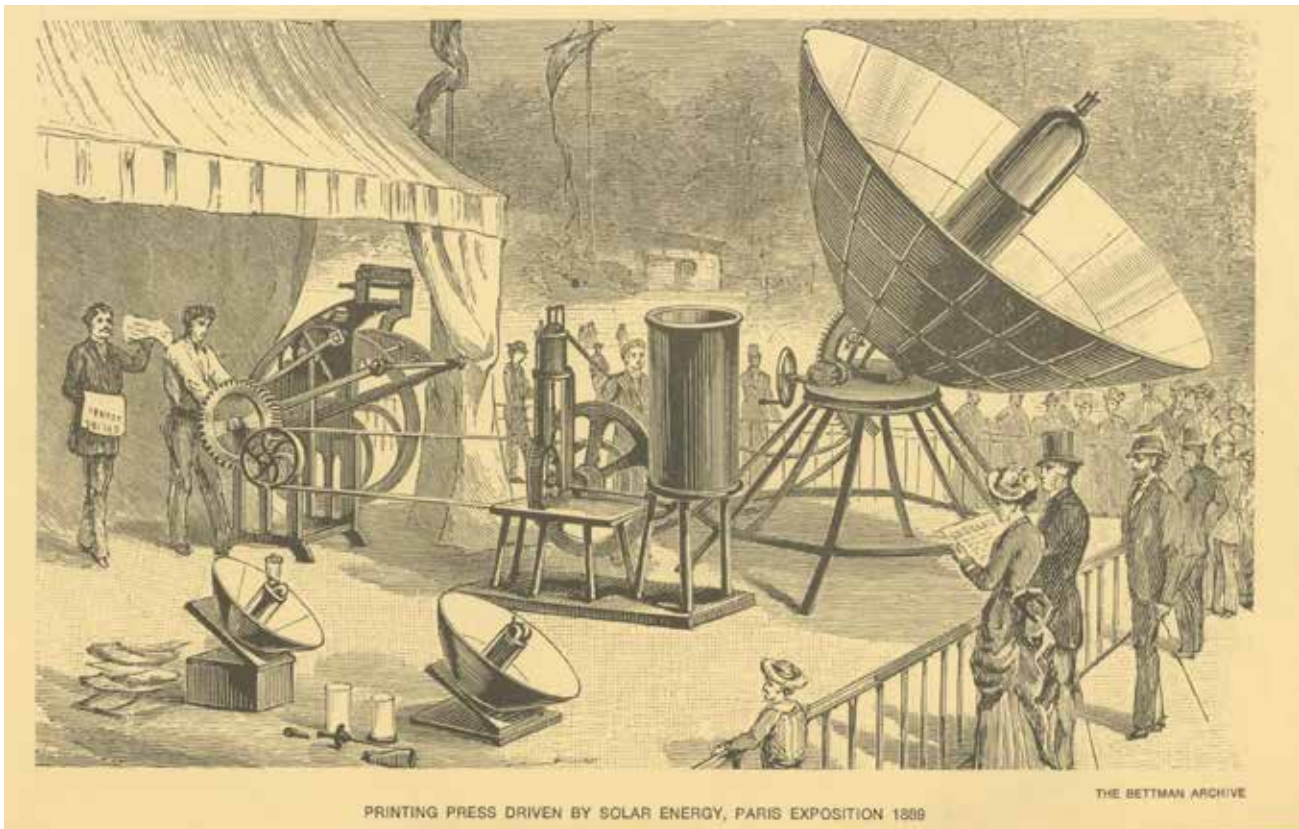

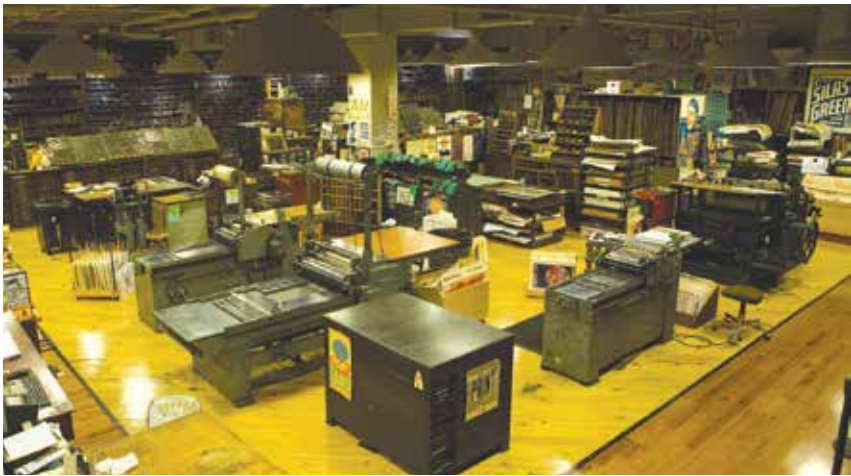

Celene Aubry and Hatch Show Print

Established in 1879, Hatch Show Print reflects the history of American advertising and entertainment, as one of the oldest letterpress design and print shops in America. Founded by the Hatch brothers, C.R. and H.H., the business blossomed in the 1920s under the steady hand of C.R.'s son Will T. Hatch, who applied his own bold style in hand carving the wood blocks.



For much of the twentieth century, the shop's vibrant posters served as a leading advertising medium for southern entertainment, ranging from vaudeville and minstrel shows to magicians and opera singers, from Negro League baseball games to B-movies, from members of the Grand Ole Opry like Bill Monroe, Minnie Pearl and Ernest Tubb, to rock n' roll impresarios such as Elvis Presley and Chuck Berry. In the twenty-first century, musicians and entertainers



from around the world call on Hatch Show Print to design and print eye-catching, iconic posters.

The designers at Hatch Show Print celebrate the craftsmanship that goes into the daily tasks of design and letterpress printing. Everything they create draws inspiration from the vast collection of wood and metal type and hand-carved print blocks created in the shop; the process and the results are indeed a tonic for the digital age.

Celene Aubry is the Director and Shop Manager at Hatch Show Print. While the business thrives as a letterpress poster and design shop, expanded programming includes a visiting artist program, a gallery show-

casing print-centric art, a gift shop and hands-on tours and workshops from the education space. In between poster runs, she also enjoys making cyanotypes and van Dyke photoprints, in addition to letterpress printing especially in collaborations that lend the power of the press to fellow citizens.



AN EXPERIENCE LIKE NO OTHER

The International Printing Museum features the world's largest collection of working antique printing presses, such as the dramatic 1824 Columbian Press pictured here. Be inspired through working tours of the collection; print on Gutenberg's Press of 1450, or make an Almanac on Ben Franklin's colonial press!

The Museum's galleries are filled with the machines and tools of the graphic arts industry from historic Chinese printing blocks to the cast-iron newspaper presses of the 19th century. Marvel at the clattering sounds of the 1890 Linotype that changed the world and enjoy the stories of Ben Franklin and how books and printing shaped his life.
